RUPPINER GASTRO - CARE

To stabilise physiological digestion



Ruppiner Gastro - Care is a feed supplement that can help support the regeneration of the gastric mucosa. There are a variety of different triggers for gastric mucosal lesions, stomach ulcers, colic or general stomach problems in horses. Common causes are mistakes in feeding management, stress, transport, diseases, but also social imbalances in the herd. Ruppiner Gastro - Care helps to balance and buffer excess stomach acid. In this way, a natural digestive environment can be promoted. Unlike other products, it does not inhibit the production of stomach acid, but buffers excess stomach acid in a natural way. It also contains valuable components that can help form a protective layer for the stomach lining. Special calcium carbonate compounds bind the excess stomach acid. Other ingredients such as extruded linseed and brewer's yeast contribute to the formation of a protective layer on the stomach lining. Live yeast serves as a probiotic, can improve the habitat for anaerobic bacteria and promote fibre digestion. Ruppiner Gastro - Care is particularly suitable for horses that tend to have a sensitive stomach or stomach ulcers. But it is also suitable for horses that are susceptible to stress, before transports or other stressful situations.

Feeding recommendation: Due to the higher content of Saccharomyces cerevisiae CNCM I-1077 (E1711/4b1711/4a1711) compared to complete feeds, this supplementary feed may only be fed to horses with up to 30 g per 100 kg body weight and day. We recommend an administration of 15 g - 30 g / 100 kg body weight / day. For an optimal effect we recommend to divide the feeding into at least 2 meals per day and to mix it into the daily concentrated feed. For a large horse (600 kg) we recommend 90 g - 180 g / animal / day. The feeding recommendation refers to a roughage intake (hay) of 1.5 kg per 100 kg body weight and day. The optimal dosage should be determined individually for each horse. Ruppiner Gastro-Care should be administered over a period of up to four weeks. Note: It is recommended to seek the advice of a veterinarian if stomach ulcers are suspected.
